Here's what we're doing to help fight the spread of COVID-19.

Enhanced cleaning

- Since March, Amtran has significantly increased our cleaning regimen especially high touch areas like the farebox, grab bars and rails, etc.

Touchless fare-paying

- Our [myFare Smart Card](#) allows customers to “tap and go,” and it accommodates all [fares](#) – adults, students, people with disabilities, etc. To see how it works, click on [this video](#).
- [Senior Citizens](#) (65 and over) just flash their [PA Senior Ride Free Card](#) to the driver. If you don't [have](#) one, call our **HelpLine** (944-4074), and find out how to [get](#) one.
- [Penn State Altoona students](#) just flash their student ID to the driver.

Alerting our customers about crowded trips.

- Our [myStop app](#) shows you in [real time](#) how many people are riding every one of our buses. The app is available as a free download for iOS and Android devices.
- Amtran updates our [website](#) frequently on which trips are crowded so that you can adjust your travel plans.

Adding buses at higher ridership times – We have “standby buses” that are assigned during peak times to follow a bus on its regular route to help relieve over-crowding.

Mandatory masks – Following PA state guidelines, masks are required while riding or waiting for the bus (unless you have a serious health condition that would prevent you from doing so).
