myFare Smart Card

With the new myFare Smart Card you don't have to worry about carrying exact change. Just tap myFare on the electronic card reader and your fare is automatically deducted. It's that quick and easy.

Your myFare Smart Card can be reloaded anytime when boarding any bus. Adding \$15 or more to your myFare Smart Card gets you a 15% bonus. For example, add \$15 and get an extra \$2.25 on your card. Add \$20 and get an extra \$3 on your card.

Vehicle Accessibility Features

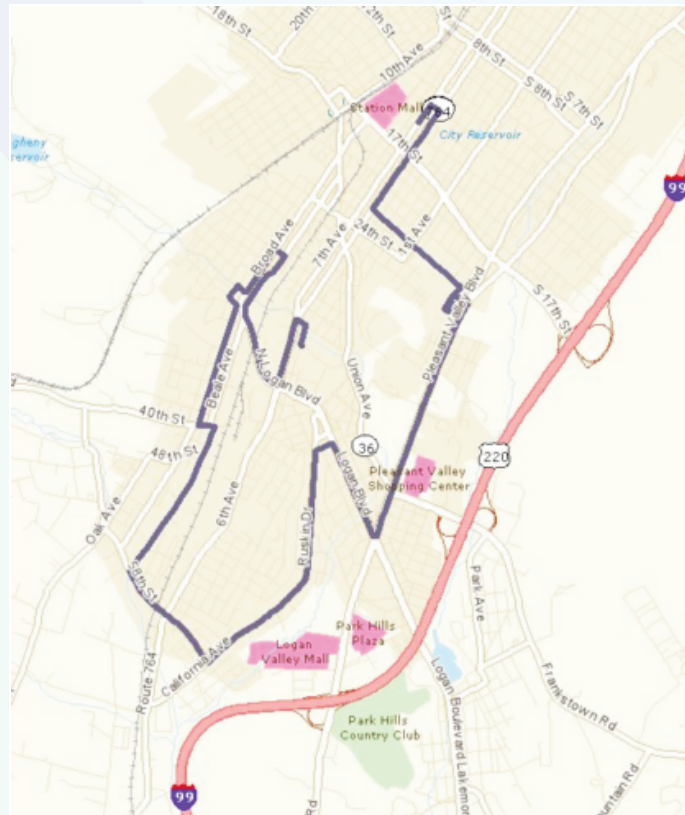
